

# **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**MY DECK PROJECT









## FLOOD® CWF-UV®5

Ideal for newer wood, Flood CWF-UV5 is a premium product that adds minimal color and highlights the natural wood grain. Its penetrating formula is long-lasting, offering superior sun and rain protection. See the product label for more information and details regarding application.

- 1. Cover everything you do not wish to coat, including plants.
- Make sure the wood surface has been properly prepared and is completely dry. (See flood.com/guideme for help choosing the right prep product based on the type and condition of the wood.)
- 3. For color uniformity, intermix all containers being used, and do not thin the product.
- 4. Stir the finish before and periodically during application.
- 5. Test the color, if applicable, in a small area.
- 6. Apply an even coat with a synthetic brush, roller or airless sprayer, avoiding heavy application.
- 7. After spray application, backbrush or backroll to improve penetration and uniformity of coverage. Remember, Flood CWF-UV5 is not a surface coating. It protects by penetrating the wood surface.
- 8. For porous or older wood, if required, apply a second coat before the first coat has dried (within 20 minutes).
- 9. Allow surfaces to dry for 24 to 48 hours.

## **APPLICATION OPTIONS**

- · Synthetic brush
- Roller
- · Airless sprayer

## **WEATHER REQUIREMENTS**

- Apply CWF-UV5 in temperatures between 50° and 90° F.
- Do not apply CWF-UV5 if cold and/or wet weather is expected within 24 hours.

## **APPLICATION TIPS**

- To avoid lap marks, always work the entire length of a board while maintaining a wet edge. Never stop application in the middle of the board.
- Vertical surfaces should be coated from top to bottom.

## **CLEANUP**

• Clean tools with soap and water.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- Wear safety glasses.
- Do not apply CWF-UV5 in direct sunlight or on hot surfaces.
- CWF-UV5 is for exterior use only; do not use it indoors.
