#### Performance Characteristics:

- Resists the damaging effects of ultra-violet light, temperature extremes and weathering that cause hardening, cracking, crumbling of oil-based sealants.
- Wet or dry surface application.
- Will not run or bubble.

# Surface Preparation & Application:

- 1. Remove loose, damaged asphalt or old repair material from surface.
- 2. Cut nozzle at 45° angle to desired bead size.
- 3. Puncture inner foil seal.
- 4. Load cartridge into caulk gun.
- 5. Fill cracks and gaps with sealant.
- 6. Sets tack free in less than one hour. A complete cure is attained in two to four weeks, depending on temperature, humidity and depth of fill.
- 7. Paintable after one hour of application. High quality oil or asphalt-based paint is recommended. One coat may show a slight discoloration. Two coats will provide a clean film.

# For Best Results:

- Apply in temperatures between 40°F and 100°F.
- Joint size should not exceed 3/8"wide x 3/8"deep. If joint depth exceeds 3/8", use foam backer rod.
- Store caulk away from extreme heat or cold.

Clean up excess uncured sealant with mineral spirits. Excess cured sealant must be cut or scraped away. Do not use mineral spirits to clean skin. Clean hands with warm, soapy water. Store product away from extreme heat or moisture.
